

The Second Coming of Jesus: a solution for obtaining world peace

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Introduction

There are many verses in the Bible about the Second Coming of Jesus, but they do not indicate exactly when this will occur. For example, Matthew 24.44 "Therefore you also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect". This site gives 100 verses about the Second Coming of Jesus.

It appears that the Qur'an does not give such indication about the Second Coming of Jesus as given by this site.

To be the Second Coming of Christ would suggest the following:

- 1) One needs to be Jewish and male (since Jesus was a male Jew). The author is a Jewish male born on the 26th June 1977.
- 2) An out-of-body experience where the soul leaves the body and visualising a bird in the spiritual world (similar to when Jesus was baptized Mathew 3:16 "And when Jesus was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him").
- 3) A dead bird present a few days later after the out-of-body experience (most likely three days) with no body (only the feathers) as a form of "resurrection" in the same surroundings as to where the out-of-body experience occurred.
- 4) Able to show there are no contradictions between the Bible and the Qur'an in relation to Jesus (since God is perfect and would not have contradictions).
- 5) Able to obtain the best solution to obtaining world peace since the appearance of Jesus and all documented and uploaded freely on say a website.

Firstly, the disappearance of Srila Prabhupada (commentary for the Bhagavad Gita As It Is in disciplic succession from Lord Krishna - the Supreme Personality of Godhead) occurred in 1977. This is the same year the author was born. It seems reasonable that when Srila Prabhupada leaves that the Second Coming of Jesus appears.

In March/April 2013 a series of three separate events took place for the author of a spiritual nature at his student residence 22/122 Culloden Rd, Marsfield, Sydney. The first event featured a black bird tapping its beak on the author's front glass door several times before turning its head to look the author in the eye, and then flying off. The second event involved a black bird swooping down from the opposite apartment and pecking on the door several times/looking the author in the eye in the same spot of the previous bird before flying off. The author was standing in the kitchen of his apartment at the time when a strange feeling of energy was felt (as a force) whilst observing the bird swooping down. During this process the author's sense of hearing appeared to block the surrounding sounds and a strange

'whizzing' sound was heard of the bird flying down to the door. The third event featured the skin/feathers of a 'dead' black bird appearing in roughly the same spot that the previous birds had pecked on the door. The exact dates of these events are difficult to trace but can be confirmed to have taken place between the 27th March and the 8th April, 2013. These events occurred as a direct result of making the connection with yoga and conflict resolution within an ideology, such that 'Yoga is the most effective method to resolving conflicts'. Given that all religions are circumstantial for their period in history, it can therefore be concluded that this ideology and associated policies is a revelation that has been approved by God as a method for how society today should function to assist to bring about world peace. This is documented in 'The Book of Tristan' ([pdf](#)). The events also appear to symbolize Jesus, since the final event featured a dead bird with no body present and hence a 'resurrection'. The author's 'out-of-body' experience was such that the author was 'killed' by God and then raised from the dead. Also, the best explanation for how the feathers appeared on the author's doorstep days after the 'out-of-body' experience is such that a Spirit Being descended and placed them there and this Spirit Being was actually God, since from Vedic literature there are many incarnations of God. To be killed by God and raised from the dead in such an 'out-of-body' experience is a very high achievement that any individual can obtain. For this reason, the author has been appointed by God as the next King for the Jewish people following Messiah Jesus. It is worth noting that the author had very little understanding of religion and spiritual knowledge prior to these spiritual encounters. The significance of the author's 'out-of-body' experience whilst visualizing a bird is directly connected with the Bible. Mathew 3:16 "And when Jesus was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him". The author contacted the Australian Institute of Parapsychological Research about the spiritual encounters. The response was that the out-of-body experiences (which occur in about 20% of the population) was not a typical out-of-body experience which is regarded as a veridical out-of-body experience. One of the reviewers regarded it as something more of a mystical experience and therefore can be regarded as something very unique. Based on the above does this imply that the author is actually the Second Coming of Jesus, given the out-of-body experience involving a bird in the spiritual world with a similar experience to when Jesus was baptized and a dead bird appearing a few days later (possibly 3 days) but with no body present (only the feathers) as a form of "resurrection"? Since these experiences, the author has shown that there are no contradictions between the Bible and the Qur'an in relation to Jesus (after all God is perfect and would not have contradictions) and hence the truth about Jesus which should unite the three Abrahamic religions, a solution to peace in the Middle East, a solution to employment for indigenous Australians, a fairer Australian federal election voting system to reflect indigenous cultural heritage, the solution to bigotry, a solution for providing for the homeless, unemployed and poverty globally, a solution to housing affordability, a solution to forcing cooperation in the workplace as an economic model (to increase average salary and overall happiness), an ideology and set of policies (with 5 key policies identified for a global scale) to reflect many values and morals as documented in religious scriptures as well as preventing/resolving conflicts, a lifestyle to obtain constant 'happiness' by being elevated to a transcendental state of consciousness, and

subsequently achieve a spiritual body in the afterlife (which is our purpose in life), a solution to minimize depression and anxiety by advancing spiritually (where depression is the world's biggest health problem – estimated globally at 30%), and spiritual counselling through social media minimize depression and anxiety as a completely free service.

Hence, it is believed that the author has the best solution to obtaining world peace such that it is better than what anyone else has ever come up with since the appearance of Jesus on earth. This will all be explained throughout this article.

How Spiritual Advancement can Prevent and Resolve Mental Health Disorders

If someone is bullied to the state that they are suicidal then this is very serious. The victim should be compensated about 10 million dollars and the injurer should be jailed for about 40 years. Essentially workplace bullying could be considered equivalent to murder. The author has experienced psychosis, panic attacks, generalized anxiety disorder, depression as well as being suicidal in the years 2010-2019 as a result of workplace bullying.

The first real sign of the author's improvement in health occurred on the 11th Feb 2013, which was the day before enrolment for a course in a Bachelor of Social Science degree at Macquarie University. At this point in time the author was also undertaking regular Hatha yoga sessions at Macquarie Gym. The author's health continued to improve throughout 2013. This was assisted by weekly attendance at the Macquarie University Bhakti Yoga club, weekly visits to the Hare Krishna temple, Sydney and reading books of spiritual knowledge available at the Hare Krishna Temple. Throughout 2013 the author also had regular chiropractic and remedial massage treatments. However, the most effective method for resolving mental health came from regular visits to the Hare Krishna temple and daily chanting of the Hare Krsna Mantra: Hare Krsna, Hare Krsna, Krsna Krsna, Hare Hare / Hare Rama, Hare Rama, Rama Rama, Hare Hare. The author would continue the chanting of mantras by weekly visits to Govindas, Sydney in 2014. The author's health significantly improved after reading the Bhagavad Gita As It Is for the 3rd time in May 2019, where the depression disappeared completely, the anxiety significantly eased off; and thus the author successfully came off anti-depressant drugs. From the 26th May 2019, the author became strictly vegetarian and no consumption of alcohol but still enjoys one cappuccino a day. Further on the 26th June 2019 which coincided with the author's birthday, the generalized anxiety disorder disappeared completely and the anti-anxiety medication was reduced to very low doses. Also, on the 26th June 2019 the author had an experience where it felt like being elevated off the floor. This is regarded as a higher state of consciousness than walking on water.

This article has demonstrated how spiritual advancement (which cannot be explained by science) can resolve mental health disorders, in particular depression and generalized anxiety disorder. Hence there is evidence to suggest that all mental disorders (and even physical disorders) can be resolved through spiritual advancement, as given by evidence of the healing powers of Jesus. If mental health disorders can be resolved then the reverse of preventative measures for mental health disorders could also be obtained through spiritual advancement. Note that the mental health disorders for the author were caused by workplace bullying, and hence this issue should be taken more seriously, in particular regarded as a serious criminal offence (possibly even murder) as it can cause one to suicide.

Bhagavad Gita

The Bhagavad Gita is a conversation between Arjuna, a supernaturally gifted warrior about to go into battle, and Krishna – the Supreme Personality of Godhead, his charioteer. In the course of giving Arjuna all manner of spiritual and material advice, Krishna explains karma, the self, the Supreme Self, the purpose of yoga, the difference between our self and our material body, how our environment affects our consciousness, and how to attain the perfection of life. The Gita appears as a central chapter in the Mahabharata, the history of greater India. It is the essence of Vedic knowledge and one of the most important books of Vedic literature. Lord Krishna spoke the Bhagavad Gita to Arjuna about 5000 years ago and through disciplic succession the Bhagavad Gita As It Is gives commentary on the verses by Lord Krishna by His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Pradhupada. Essentially the Bhagavad Gita As It Is is the highest authoritative text to explain the universe and the commentary is “almost” 100% accurate.

What defines a human

From the Bhagavad Gita As It Is our bodies are composed of both material and spiritual. The material body contains the gross body (earth, water, fire, air and space) and the subtle body (mind, intelligence and false ego). But above all these elements there is the spiritual soul. There’s no life in the material elements, life is the spiritual soul which is eternal, full of knowledge and bliss. The soul contains two parts the individual soul and the Supersoul (a plenary expansion of God). The soul is one ten thousandth the size of the tip of a hair and is located in the heart, and cannot be measured under laboratory conditions. The material body is currently dead. The only thing keeping it alive is the soul or consciousness (energy emitted by the soul). At the end of this life we reincarnate into another body depending on our karma. Ideally you want to achieve a spiritual body and escape the re-birth and death process and hence travel the entire universe with Krishna in total bliss – that is our purpose in life. Three quarters of the universe is spiritual. There are 8.4 million species of life including 400,000 species of humans (based on our level of consciousness). Every form of life contains an individual soul and a Supersoul.

Types of life

Typically, there is plant, animal and human forms of life. But there is a higher form of human life known as demigods but still have a material body (they are not God, which is purely spiritual). Demigods can typically walk through walls, walk on water and have healing powers. Jesus for example was a demigod. Through quantum tunneling it is proven scientifically that a human can walk through a wall with a very low probability. The highest level of consciousness for a human is walking through a wall. Therefore, it could be argued that a demigod is in fact the highest form of a human. This also shows the transition from material

to spiritual knowledge. It is well established in the Bible that Jesus as a demigod had healing powers (Jesus even brought someone back to life). This somewhat proves scientifically that any disease can be cured by spiritual advancement.

Karma

According to Vedic literature and outlined in the Bhagavad Gita As It Is, karma is the law of cause and effect. For every action there is a cause as well as a reaction. Karma is produced by performing fruitive activities for bodily or mental development. One may perform pious activities that will produce good reactions or good karma for future enjoyment. Or one may perform selfish or what some call sinful activities that produce bad karma and future suffering. This follows a person wherever he or she goes in this life or future lives. Such karma, as well as the type of consciousness a person develops, establishes reactions that one must experience. So, when the living beings take birth again, they get a certain kind of body that is most suitable for the type of consciousness they have developed. There are 8.4 million species of life, each offering a particular class of body for whatever kind of desires and consciousness the living being may have in this world. In this way, the living entity is the son of his past and the father of his future. Thus, he is presently affected by his previous life's activities and creates his future existence by the actions he performs in this life. A person will reincarnate into various forms of bodies that are most suitable for the living entity's consciousness, desires, and for what he deserves. So, the living being inevitably continues in this cycle of birth and death and the consequences for his various good or bad activities as long as he is materially motivated. For example, if one chooses to eat meat, then they run the risk of being reincarnated into a tiger since tigers are used to eating meat. If a young girl walks around half naked attracting attention of the opposite sex, then they run the risk of being reincarnated into a tree since trees stand their naked all day.

Types of yoga

Yoga can be classified into four types: Hatha Yoga, Karma Yoga, Jnana Yoga and Bhakti Yoga. Yoga is typically known amongst Western society as Hatha Yoga and this is generally the way society is introduced to yoga by performing postures in a gym. Karma Yoga generally applies to our working lives; where carried out properly one should not become attached to the results of their work but rather all the work is done for the Supreme and owned by the Supreme, and thus the living entity has no reactions of lamentation or hankering. Jnana Yoga is about knowledge of the absolute and typically applies to knowledge that we obtain throughout our educational experiences. The problem with Western society is the knowledge taught at secondary and tertiary level is focused on 'material' knowledge rather than spiritual or true knowledge. The highest form of yoga is Bhakti Yoga (which also integrates elements of Hatha, Karma and Jnana Yoga); and this is a complete devotion to the Supreme. Religion could also be considered a form of Bhakti Yoga since religion generally involves worshipping a Supreme. However, the highest form of Bhakti Yoga is Krishna Consciousness (also known as the Hare Krishna movement). This involves regular chanting of the Hare Krishna mantra and abstaining from sense gratification of smoking, gambling, alcohol, meat-eating and illicit sex (and even no egg, onion or garlic). By following a yoga process one can progress in spiritual life and increase their level of consciousness.

Truth about Jesus

The following verses are outlined in the Qur'an:

4:159 That they said (in boast), "We killed Christ Jesus the son of Mary, the Messenger of Allah";-but they killed him not, nor crucified him, but so it was made to appear to them, and those who differ therein are full of doubts, with no (certain) knowledge, but only conjecture to follow, for of a surety they killed him not.

9:30 And the Jews say, Ezra is the son of Allah, and the Christians say, the Messiah is the son of Allah; that is what they say with their mouths. They imitate the saying of those who disbelieved before them. Allah's curse be on them! How are they turned away!.

It is also implied in The Qur'an that 'Jesus is not God and is not the Son of God'

The Bhagavad Gita As It Is refers to Lord Krishna as the Supreme Soul, fully spiritual, omnipotent and omniscient and cannot suffer the miseries that we do in this material world. Jesus had a material body. The Holy Spirit is a plenary expansion of God and is located in the heart. This is more commonly known as the Supersoul which is present in every living entity. There are 8.4 million species of life. Any human can potentially pass through a barrier, known as quantum tunnelling. Therefore, Jesus walking out of the enclosed tomb is somewhat trivial. But why did Jesus walk out of the tomb with a material body (rather than a higher spiritual body)? This is because Jesus thought he was God (when in fact he was a demigod). That is why Jesus thought he could forgive sin. So, Jesus was reincarnated at death into another demigod body. Demigods are capable of ascending to heavenly material planets but have to return to earth at some point in time to take on another body. That explains the Second Coming of Jesus. God gave Jesus healing powers, to walk on water, walk through walls and foresee the future (typical of demigods). Jesus claims that he and the Father are one. As explained previously the Holy Spirit (a plenary expansion of God is present in the heart of Jesus). The Holy Spirit (or more generally the Supersoul) is present in all living entities along with the individual soul. The soul is one ten thousandth the size of a tip of hair and is eternal and cannot be destroyed, but merely transmigrates into another body at the end of each life based on our karma. The Father is mentioned several times in the Bhagavad Gita As It Is as being God, and the Father is purely spiritual. The Father, Yahweh and Allah and incarnations of Lord Krishna – the Supreme Personality of Godhead. Jesus was not the Son of God but rather a son of God. In fact all humans are sons of God because we are part-and-parcel with God. The Qur'an states that Jesus was not killed but was made to believe so. From the Bhagavad Gita As It Is we are not these material bodies but eternal souls and therefore cannot be killed. Our bodies are changed from one form to the next at the end of each life according to our karma. If we have bad karma then we can descend to being reincarnated as an animal. Good karma will get us to a spiritual body and ascend to a spiritual planet and live in eternal bliss with God, and escape the process of death and rebirth. This is our purpose in life to obtain a spiritual body in the afterlife. There are 400,000 species of humans based on our level of consciousness (energy emitted from the soul). The material body is dead. The only thing keeping it alive is the soul (or consciousness - energy emitted by the soul). The highest level of consciousness is walking through a wall – which is typical of demigods. Therefore, the highest form of human is in fact a demigod. There is an even higher form of life than demigods

that is still not God. Jesus was the Son of Man, Messiah (meaning anointed King) and savior for the world at the point in time in history. However, Jesus was insulting God by claiming to be God and the Jews were correct in crucifying him. Therefore, Jesus failed to save the world.

Hence there are no contradictions between the Bible and the Qur'an in relation to Jesus.

There are nearly 100 biblical passages discussing the Second Coming of Jesus Christ, but there is no clear indication on when and how he will return. Jesus told His disciples: "No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father... Two men will be in the field; one will be taken and the other left. Two women will be grinding with the hand mill; one will be taken and the other left... Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come" (Matthew 24:36, 40, 42). From the Bible it is revealed that Jesus received a material body after the crucifixion rather than a spiritual body. This further implies that Jesus was insulting God by claiming to be God. It can be argued that this material body was in fact another demigod body, since demigods are capable of ascending to demigod planets. Whilst Jesus was on this demigod planet he was still claiming to be God and after dying on this demigod planet was reincarnated into a lower form of life as a human – arguably being the author based on the spiritual encounters that reflect Jesus. This is the law of karma. Life is eternal and we reincarnate into another species of life based on our karma until we obtain a spiritual body and escape the re-birth and death process.

A Solution to peace in the Middle East

The author's out-of-body (and somewhat mystical) experience appears to reflect when Jesus was baptized, a dead bird appearing a few days later but with no body present (only the feathers) as a form of 'resurrection', and the reincarnation process based on the law of karma; possibly suggests that the author is actually the Second Coming of Jesus. Based on Christian Zionism where some Christian Zionists believe that the gathering of the Jews in Israel is a prerequisite for the Second Coming of Jesus, therefore provides some authority for the author to decide on the best method to obtain peace in the Middle East. Lord Krishna the Supreme Personality of Godhead created the entire universe and therefore owns all land and at a high state of consciousness you can view all living entities as eternal souls and not this material body covering. Given that our whole purpose in life is to obtain a spiritual body in the afterlife and avoid the re-birth and death process, it is critically important to respect all life and in particular human life by avoiding warfare, prolonging life as much as possible and having equal rights for all citizens in the land of Israel based on the law of karma to obtain that spiritual body. Further, the author has shown that there are no contradictions between the Bible and the Qur'an (in particular in relation to Jesus – after all God is perfect and would not have contradictions) and this should unite the three Abrahamic religions and the church therefore should consist of Jews, Muslims and Christians all worshipping Yahweh, Allah and the Father respectively. Even though there is evidence to suggest that Jesus is not God, the teachings of Jesus still have a high level of moral conduct and Christians still have a religion by worshipping the Father and following the teachings of Jesus. Further, it was suggested that Jesus was insulting God by claiming to be God, but Jews and Muslims should still respect Jesus since in Krishna consciousness every living entity is given respect (8.4 million species in life), since every living entity is viewed as eternal souls and not the material body covering. Based on the law of karma the estimated 6 million Jews that were killed during the Holocaust,

implies that Hitler will descend into a lower form of life and the victims that were killed are likely to ascend into a higher form of life (most likely a spiritual body and live in eternal bliss with God). Ilan Pappé is a leading historian on the Arab/Israel conflict and identifies that Zionism is dangerous for peace in the Middle East and supports a One-State solution.

Based on the above the concept of Zionism should be abolished, a One-State solution should be obtained and equal rights should be given to all citizens in the land of Israel (and the Apartheid Analogy if it occurs should be non-existent). Further, The Bhagavad Gita As It Is and The Book of Tristan should be distributed and read throughout the Middle East (in particular politicians) and yogic philosophy should be taught at primary and secondary school education (and ultimately globally), based on the understanding that our purpose in life is to obtain a spiritual body in the afterlife, that there are no contradictions between the Bible and Qur'an in relation to Jesus and yoga is the most effective method to resolving conflicts.

Ideology

The Strategic Games ideology aims for the creation of a society that most effectively prevents and resolves conflicts. The traditional conflict resolution model utilizes adjudicative processes (i.e. litigation, arbitration) and warfare. The modern and arguably more effective conflict resolution model utilizes consensual processes (i.e. negotiation, mediation, facilitation) and free speech. Whilst consensual processes are a key element to the Strategic Games ideology; the most effective model to resolve (and prevent) conflicts is through following a yoga process.

One of the main problems with political ideologies (liberal, conservative, social democracy, greens, communist, etc.) is the very material nature they operate. The material environment does not reflect on the spiritual environment which is precisely the world/universe that we live in, as typically present in religious ideologies. Political ideologies view 'happiness' through material sense gratification (such as wealth). In comparison religious ideologies view 'happiness' as spiritual, where by controlling the senses from such material elements one can obtain spiritual realization through the soul which is beyond the miseries that exist within this material world. There is evidence to support the assertion that our current capitalist society is getting worse in terms of the individual's well-being and happiness. This is evident through the increasing levels of mental health. The Mental Health Foundation of Australia says: "One in five of us will experience depression at some time in our life. The World Health Organisation has concluded that by 2020, depression will be the world's major health problem." Hence, true happiness and world peace abroad can only be obtained once mental health problems are resolved and this requires an ideology with foundations in religious practices such as worshipping a Supreme/God and abstaining from material sense gratification. In effect, this process of engaging in the spiritual world will eventually clear any mental disturbances in the mind. However, in our multicultural and market driven capitalist societies, implementing a particular religious doctrine as an ideology for running the economy is likely to fail (since there are many different religions). This is where yoga becomes an important part of an ideology,

since yoga itself is defined as 'connecting with the soul' and embraces all religions by worshipping to a Supreme Being (whether a Christian, Hindu, Muslim, Jew etc).

Through yoga processes of meditation, chanting and an understanding of yogic philosophy; the individual/s will be in a more relaxed mental state to make better informed decisions. It is precisely the mental state and overall well-being of the individual which are critical to resolving conflicts during consensual type processes; and the practice of yoga in particular can be used to coordinate this goal. This model demonstrates that health and conflict resolution processes become directly connected. Strategic Games therefore argues that public funding should prioritise facilities for yoga and other health related areas including sporting facilities, and regular dentist, chiropractic and remedial massage check-ups.

Policies

The following policies reflect many values and morals as documented in religious scriptures as well as preventing/resolving conflicts. For example, to reflect on the Sixth Commandment "Thou shall not kill", a policy has been implemented to stop the killing and abuse of animals for food or other forms of human satisfaction.

Health

- Yoga meditation and related activities fully subsidized by the government
- Allow the community free access to all council sporting facilities
- Make accessible relevant statistical information on all games at the particular gambling venue
- Mandatory dispute resolution processes in the workplace with the option of third-party government facilitators that do not have an invested interest in either side of the disputants
- Six-monthly regular dentist check-ups (including cleaning) fully subsidized by the government
- Six-monthly regular chiropractic check-ups fully subsidized by the government
- Six-monthly regular remedial massage check-ups fully subsidized by the government
- Real-time prescription medication monitoring
- Tobacco and other smoking drugs to be illegalized
- Legal age for gambling activities and consumption of alcohol to be 21
- Workplace bullying to be equivalent to murder

Social Justice

- Allow major sporting events to be televised on free-to-air
- Allow all types of gamblers (including professional and card-counters) to participate under the rules of the particular game without any interrogation and heat from the gambling establishment.
- Adjudicative processes are not allowed in civil law disputes; but rather mandatory third-party facilitation processes are utilized if required

- Bag checking not allowed in retail stores
- Fines and penalties to be abolished on public transport for not travelling with a valid ticket
- Sentencing to be abolished for crimes contributed by mental disorders where there are no signs of physical harm to an individual
- The tenant has the option to not allow inspections during the term of the lease for the residential property
- Objective based formula that determines rental increase that is standardized across the rental property market.
- Implement a system that provides an allowance for unemployment regardless of financial status such that the allowance is comparable to the minimum wage. The allowance is also given to tertiary students.
- Governments cannot seize property for failure to pay fines/infringements.
- Implement a system where all monetary transactions are centralized through a taxation office and taxes debited accordingly.
- Credit card or other monetary deposits are not allowed for short-term accommodation (less than 1 month) during the accommodation period.
- The ownership of residential property is both private and government; where private ownership cannot be used in rental and government ownership is only used in rental.
- Stop the killing and abuse of animals for food or other forms of human satisfaction
- Prohibit any form of reality gambling (sports, racing, elections, reality TV etc)
- Prohibit online gambling
- Ban prostitution and the sex industry in general
- Legal age for sexual activity to be 18
- Cheating on a partner once married to be recognized as an illegal activity
- Abortion regarded as an illegal activity
- Ban the contraceptive pill
- Euthanasia regarded as an illegal activity

Education

- Sport and gambling examples to be integrated in the mathematics high school curriculum
- Compulsory high school education on mainstream religions and indigenous cultures
- Compulsory primary and secondary school education on yogic philosophy
- Compulsory high school education on work agreements and taxation
- Compulsory high school education on political systems and forms of government
- Compulsory yoga meditation and related activities to be a daily practice within schools
- Student information including exam results and progress to remain strictly confidential throughout high school education and not to be circulated by the school to parents/guardians

Peace

- Minimize security in religious institutions and allow different cultures and religions to enter the premises as welcomed guests without any form of interrogation including personal questions
- Disallow any form of warfare and weaponry for conflict resolution
- Include annual public holidays to represent the three major Abrahamic religions of Judaism, Christianity and Islam
- Allow genuine asylum seekers into a country without mandatory detention

To assist in obtaining world peace and to assist in obtaining a spiritual body in the afterlife (which is our purpose in life) eight key policies have been identified from the above based on yogic philosophy.

The number 1 policy is:

Compulsory primary and secondary school education on yogic philosophy

- 2) Tobacco and other smoking drugs to be illegalized
- 3) Workplace bullying to be equivalent to murder
- 4) Stop the killing and abuse of animals for food or other forms of human satisfaction
- 5) Ban prostitution and the sex industry in general
- 6) Abortion regarded as an illegal activity
- 7) Ban the contraceptive pill
- 8) Euthanasia regarded as an illegal activity

Economic Model

The economic model is based on resolving class conflict in the workplace as this represents the most important conflict based on our everyday lives; and would therefore reflect on the economy as a whole including welfare. This also reflects on Marxist theory on class conflict in the workplace which has been a major factor in the formulation of left/right political ideologies. From yogic philosophy there are three of modes of material nature that we are all subject to causing miseries in this material world. From lowest to highest these modes are ignorance, passion and goodness. The majority of society is currently in the mode of passion by always looking at ways to increase one's wealth and is characterized by the attraction between man and woman. In order to obtain a transcendental state of consciousness and be free of miseries that exist within this material world, one must firstly transcend to the mode of goodness; where in this mode the accumulation of wealth is not the main priority but rather sharing the accumulation of wealth towards helping others. However, one's happiness in the mode of goodness may not necessarily be greater than one's happiness in the mode of passion. For example, in a working environment, employers are generally in the mode of passion (at least within Australian business) as their level of happiness tends to be greater in this mode regardless of the mode of nature that is present from the employees. This is reflected by the Australian unemployment system since under the current unemployment system there are many restrictions for obtaining unemployment benefits (testing of assets for example) and the unemployment benefits being significantly less (about 40%) of the minimum wage. Therefore, there is no threat to the employer to cooperate since it is highly unlikely that the employee will leave the job and the level of happiness for the employer is

higher by not cooperating (and in a more serious case workplace bullying). The modes of passion and goodness could be equated to uncooperative and cooperative strategies respectively as given in Game 1. From this game, the employer will always choose the uncooperative strategies by being in the mode of passion and receive a positive level of happiness. And consequently, the employee will receive a negative level of happiness. In order for both the employer and employee to cooperative (and be in the mode of goodness) and receive a positive level of happiness requires changing the unemployment system to force cooperation.

The economic model involves introducing an unemployment system such that an allowance for unemployment is provided regardless of financial status and the allowance is comparable to the minimum wage, with the minimum wage being at least the amount given by the universal basic income (UBI). If the unemployment benefits are comparable to the minimum wage then the unemployment benefits are somewhat equivalent to the UBI. Therefore, the UBI needs to be established to provide for a reasonable standard of living. Also, the allowance is given to tertiary students. The unemployment system could be funded by an increase in the progressive taxation system and it is necessary for unemployment benefits to be paid back through taxation when work is established in the future. By introducing this employment system both the employer and employee obtain a negative level of happiness by not cooperating (mode of passion). If the employee does not cooperative, then the employer will always end up with a negative payout regardless of the strategy the employer adopts. If the employer does not cooperative, then the employee will always end up with a negative payout regardless of the strategy the employee adopts. Therefore, cooperation is forced for both parties to obtain a positive level of happiness and be in the mode of goodness. This is represented in Game 2.

Game 2: Levels of happiness under the revised unemployment system

This revised unemployment system would improve working conditions, 'fairer' pay for workers, increase cooperative ownership of productive property and consequently assist trade unions in these negotiation processes. Increasing cooperative ownership in particular has the effect of weakening private to common productive property which is in agreement with Marx's theory of resolving class conflict through common ownership. Work in general should be positive and a great lifestyle, and arguably the employee's level of happiness is greater when working with both parties cooperating, rather than receiving unemployment

benefits. However, when workers become alienated through class conflict (employer not cooperating and in a more serious case workplace bullying) then this positive lifestyle can have various health related effects. This unemployment system is likely to improve the welfare of the population through financial security. The economic model on resolving class conflict in the workplace is another example on the connectedness between health and conflict resolution processes. With an unemployment system which is comparable to the minimum wage there will be some people in society who take "advantage" of this and say surf at a beach all day and never work their whole lives. But again the average level of happiness across society will be increased. If surfers are happy and workers are happy then that is a good thing for society as a whole. Everyone needs to be occupied in life to achieve happiness and working in a job that you genuinely enjoy is a form of karma yoga that creates happiness. So essentially you are working for happiness rather than the money itself. If you become unemployed (as a result of the capitalist system where you may not be suited to that particular job and there is always an unemployment rate), then it is important to have financial security by having unemployment benefits comparable to the minimum wage until you are able to find another job that would be stimulating and generate happiness. Being unemployed and not getting unemployment benefits comparable to the minimum wage could lead to depression and even scale into poverty.

Lifestyle

Based on the ideology and yogic philosophy the following are recommendations for a lifestyle to obtain constant 'happiness' by being elevated to a transcendental state of consciousness, and subsequently achieve a spiritual body in the afterlife.

- Follow the Ten Commandments
- Read the Bhagavad Gita As It Is and other Krsna Consciousness books
- Chanting at least 4 rounds daily of the Hare Krishna mantra
- Weekly visits to a Hare Krishna temple during Arati /Kirtan or its equivalence
- Adopt a vegetarian diet
- Avoid intoxication and reduce alcohol consumption
- Avoid smoking
- Reduce caffeine consumption
- Avoid gambling
- Participation in a physical or mind sport
- Participate in recreational activities (swimming and gardening are recommended)
- Follow a religion or its equivalence
- Restrict sex life to marriage only
- Not to become attached to the results in working life and we work only for Lord Krishna and everything is owned by Lord Krishna
- Walk for at least 1 hour each day

Public Housing

Marx indicted that there is a class conflict between landlords and tenants and introduced the following policy: The ownership of residential property is both private and government; where private ownership cannot be used in rental and government ownership is only used in

rental. The author felt this class conflict as a tenant over a dispute where the landlord (or agent in particular) felt the apartment was not kept tidy and was brought before a magistrate at the Victorian Civil Administrative Tribunal ([ipg](#)). Note that there was no actual damage to the property. It was messy in terms of papers on the floor, which is not a breach of Section 63 as stated in the Notice to Tenant. The kitchen was not kept clean, however the bathroom paint was peeling with mold and was not addressed by the agent over several years of making such a complaint – hence the author gave up on keeping the bathroom or kitchen clean as a result of the peeling of bathroom paint and built-up of mold. It was also stated by the magistrate that the author could claim compensation for the landlord not keeping the bathroom to a satisfactory level but the author never pursued this option. In the end the landlord removed the bathroom mold and peeling of paint by a complete repaint by a tradesman, and the author paid cleaners to clean the kitchen and bathroom. However, the class conflict continued when the landlord decided to increase the rent – given that the author had not been paid compensation for the build-up of mold and peeling of paint in the bathroom. Hence the following policies in agreement with Marx’s theory:

- The ownership of residential property is both private and government; where private ownership cannot be used in rental and government ownership is only used in rental.
- The tenant has the option to not allow inspections during the term of the lease for the residential property
- Objective based formula that determines rental increase that is standardized across the rental property market.

Clearly under privatisation of property the cost of rental is too high and increasing disproportionately to the amount of wages. The underlying question is what level should rental be set at?

Knowledge

As documented in the commentary in the Bhagavad Gita As It Is material knowledge is subject to error and not really “knowledge”. True knowledge comes directly from God and is not subject to error. Vedic knowledge being true knowledge which is actually a science (or the science of God) rather than a religion. The Bible and the Qur’an, although may have come directly from God can be misinterpreted because the information is not in disciplic succession. For example, the Qur’an was given to Muhammad (via an Angel as a messenger of God) and the interpretation of the information (or commentary) should be in disciplic succession from Muhammad. The author does not believe this to be the case in that disciplic succession has been lost from Muhammad to the current era. However, the commentary of the Bhagavad Gita As It Is is in disciplic succession from Lord Krishna as given by His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Pradhupada. The commentary of the Bhagavad Gita As It Is states that anyone who reads and understands the Bhagavad Gita As It Is has a much higher source of knowledge than any Professor. Based on this argument all academics should be on equal pay without academic titles such as Senior Lecturer and Professor (which is somewhat political based on a review panel), and hence a “classless” society. In comparison obtaining a title of Doctor is a “fair” process and available to everyone based on writing a thesis as the highest level of academic education. Administrative staff working for universities should arguably be on a lower (but equal) pay than academics based on their level of education being lower than academics. In order for universities to function and make decisions there needs to be a level

of hierarchy with the Vice Chancellor, Deputy Vice Chancellor, Dean of a Faculty, Head of School etc. These “titles” are purely administrative and should not use their position to exert power (or politics) over academic staff. This implies that the structure in general of organizations should take a similar approach. Also, cooperation within the organization would increase productivity (rather than workers competing within the organization). There is still competition across organizations and hence capitalism which would grow the wealth within organizations. Therefore, the average salary within an organization would be higher compared to a hierarchical structure where everyone is on a different level of salary. Of course, under this equal pay model the CEO will be on a lower income compared to the hierarchical structure model. But the primary motive for working is to be happy and under this equal pay model the average level of happiness will be higher (and arguably the happiness of the CEO will be higher). In privately owned companies the directors (including the managing director or CEO) generally own the wealth of the organization (such as shares). So the CEO is actually generating a higher long-term profit under this equal pay model. Some workers of course will not work as hard as other workers. Maybe there in the wrong job. Work itself should be a positive lifestyle of happiness (known as karma yoga) but under the current system there is alienation amongst workers, politics, abuse of power, noncooperation and more serious issues such as bullying.

Home Economics

Women are better than men at child bearing and it makes sense for women to be paid maternity leave (at their current salary) until the children attend school. Women could potentially setup a home office (assuming they have an office job) and work at say 2 hours a day whilst looking after the children. Women could also potentially work 1 day a week on weekends whilst the partner is looking after the children (assuming the woman is not a single parent). Home economics is a part of the economic system and someone has to look after the children.

Why has Marxist theory failed in the past?

Communism has possibly failed in the past because governments have become corrupt and hence a class conflict between the government and its citizens. This reflects on a democratic voting system to ensure responsible governments. You do need governments and a bureaucracy in order for society to function effectively. However, all the above does not suggest communism (anti-capitalism) but rather looking at establishing equal pay and a classless society within a particular organization but still maintaining a capitalist society across different organizations and still creating a competitive environment and establishing wealth within organizations. This would improve productivity in the workplace and significantly reduce politics, alienation, abuse of power and bullying (which is quite a serious issue). Also, the economic model as defined above would force cooperation in the workplace and hence improve productivity which would increase the average salary amongst workers and overall happiness.

Modifying the Australian Federal Election Voting System to Reflect Indigenous Cultural Heritage

It is estimated that Aboriginals have lived in Australia for at least 60,000 years and Torres Strait Islanders for at least 2,500 years. European settlement in Australia took place in 1788. Prior to 1788, 100% of the Australian population were Indigenous Australians (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders), but currently Indigenous Australians represent only 3.3% of the Australian population. Also, it is estimated that over 1 million Aboriginal people inhabited the island continent prior to European settlement in 1788. As a result of introduced diseases and other factors, this number has declined to an estimated 761,300 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in Australia as at 30th June 2017. Given this information it seems reasonable that a federal election voting system should be partitioned between Indigenous Australians and European settlers.

At the 2019 Federal election, the Liberal/National Party, Labor Party and the Greens scored 41.4%, 33.3% and 10.4% of the primary vote respectively. The Liberal/National Party formed government with 77 seats, the Labor party won 68 seats and the Greens won only 1 seat. If the voting system was based on the primary vote then clearly the Greens would have obtained more seats in the House of Representatives. Further, as mentioned above with Aboriginals living in Australia for more than 60,000+ years (before European settlement in 1788) and Indigenous Australians currently only representing 3.3% of the current Australian population, would suggest a partition in voting between Indigenous Australians and European settlers. Based on this reasoning, the Greens could have potentially won more seats in the 2019 Federal election and quite possibly even formed government. Although the author was unable to find online evidence of preference for votes amongst Indigenous Australians; based on various Aboriginal guided tours that the author has experienced and the Greens policies focus on Justice for First Nations Peoples, there is evidence to suggest that Indigenous Australians could preference voting for the Greens. <https://greens.org.au/platform/equality>

The Solution to Bigotry

The Herbert and Valmae Freilich Project for the Study of Bigotry supports research into the causes, the histories and the effects of ethnic, cultural, religious and sexual bigotry and animosity. It also promotes public discussion of how such intolerance can be combatted - and co-existence promoted - through educational and social programs. Known as the Freilich Foundation from its establishment in July 1999 until December 2018, the Project celebrates its twentieth year of continuous operations in 2019. The commemorative publication 20 Years of Freilich has been produced to mark this occasion. <https://freilich.anu.edu.au/>

18 million dollars of funding by Herbert and Valmae Freilich has been invested into this project as run through the Australian National University. Herbert Freilich also received an Order of Australia medal for setting up this project. Herbert was a medical doctor (specializing in radiology) and no expertise in the knowledge of bigotry. Valmae Freilich has no tertiary level education and is currently a board member of the foundation. The underlying question is, 20 years later has it made any difference to resolving bigotry?

Based on the above, we are not defined by whether we are Asian, Aboriginal, Jewish or this or that, but rather by our level of consciousness, and any human can increase their level of consciousness by advancing spiritually (in particular reading and understanding the Bhagavad Gita As It Is). Therefore, the best and optimally the best solution to resolving bigotry is to introduce knowledge from the Bhagavad Gita As It Is (also known as yogic philosophy) into primary and secondary school education globally, by allowing school teachers to teach this knowledge to students.

A Scientific Approach to Obtaining World Peace

Srila Prabhupada founded ISKCON in July of 1966. The incorporation document states Seven Purposes of ISKCON:

- (1) To systematically propagate spiritual knowledge to society at large and to educate all peoples in the techniques of spiritual life in order to check the imbalance of values in life and to achieve real unity and peace in the world.
- (2) To propagate a consciousness of Krishna as it is revealed in the Bhagavad Gita and Srimad Bhagavatam.
- (3) To bring the members of the Society together with each other and nearer to Krishna, the prime entity, and thus to develop the idea, within the members, and humanity, at large, that each soul is part and parcel of the quality of Godhead (Krishna).
- (4) To teach and encourage the Sankirtan movement of congregational chanting of the holy name of God as revealed in the teachings of Lord Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu.
- (5) To erect for the members, and for society at large, a holy place of transcendental pastimes, dedicated to the personality of Krishna.
- (6) To bring the members closer together for the purpose of teaching a simpler and more natural way of life.
- (7) With a view towards achieving the aforementioned purposes, to publish and distribute periodicals, magazines, books and other writings.

In particular (1) is referring to establishing peace in the world through propagation of spiritual knowledge to society at large and to educate all peoples in the techniques of spiritual life. The Bhagavad Gita As It Is is in disciplic succession from Lord Krishna – the Supreme Personality of Godhead, who descended about 5000 years ago and spoke the words on the Bhagavad Gita to his first disciple Arjuna. The Bhagavad Gita As It Is provides a commentary by His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada who is in disciplic succession from Lord Krishna. Essentially the Bhagavad Gita As It Is is the highest authoritative text to explain the universe and the commentary is “almost” 100% accurate. As quoted on p32 in the Bhagavad Gita As It Is “In this present day, people are very much eager to have one scripture, one God, one religion, and one occupation. Therefore, let there be one scripture only, one common scripture for the whole world – Bhagavad Gita. Let there be one God for the whole world – Lord Krishna. And one hymn, one mantra, one prayer – the chanting of His name: Hare Krsna, Hare Krsna, Krsna Krsna, Hare Hare / Hare Rama, Hare Rama, Rama Rama, Hare Hare; and let there be one work only – the service of the Supreme Personality of Godhead.

However, there is a disunity amongst the three Abrahamic Religions in relation to Jesus. Further, Jews will continue to follow the Old Testament, Christians will continue to mainly follow the New Testament and Muslims will continue to follow the Qur'an. Therefore, it is critically important to prove that there are no contradictions between the Bible and the Qur'an in relation to Jesus in order to assist in obtaining world peace, and hence unite the three Abrahamic religions. After all God is perfect and would not have contradictions. Also, the Bhagavad Gita As It Is does not directly establish an ideology and a set of policies that could assist in obtaining world peace. Also, the Bhagavad Gita As It Is does not directly provide a lifestyle to obtain constant 'happiness'. Further, the author experienced spiritual encounters after making the connection that "Yoga is the most effective method to resolving conflicts". This provides validity for information on the truth about Jesus, the proposed ideology and associated policies and the ultimate solution to assist in obtaining world peace.

The truth about Jesus will unite the three Abrahamic religions and hence the 'church' will consist of Christians, Muslims and Jews all worshipping Lord Krishna (or incarnations of Krishna as the Father or Allah or Yahwah). 'The Book of Tristan' will firstly be introduced into churches globally as the next chapter in God's story. This will be supported by Muslims and ultimately the Jews and hence the establishment of the 'church'. Also 'The Book of Tristan' will be taught at secondary level high school globally. A solution to employment for Indigenous Australians

Given the success of Aboriginal Australians in music (such as playing the didgeridoo, the Yothu Yindi band), the artwork (painting, basket weaving) and in elite sports performance suggests that Aboriginals (as well as Torres Straight Islanders) have a talent for these areas. Sport in education should be highly encouraged throughout education to identify particular talent which could create opportunities for Indigenous Australians to develop a career in elite sport. Also, children enjoy playing sport and this is a very healthy lifestyle. Artwork should also be highly encouraged where it appears that males overall are gifted in painting and females overall are gifted in basket weaving. Also, pottery, patchwork, rock and sand art, body painting and other arts-and-craft making, dance and other forms of artwork could be included as part of artistic education. Music should also be highly encouraged, in particular males in playing the didgeridoo and singing. This combination of art (dance, music and arts-and-crafts) could be used by Indigenous Australians for cultural experiences in tourism and could potentially be funded by the government to create further tourism. Selling of artworks such as paintings, basket weaving, didgeridoos, music CD's and other art works would create further employment (as is currently the case). Similarly, stories of Aboriginal history in the country could be used in tourism to create sustainable employment.

Storytelling such as dreamtime stories have been traditionally used in education and should be encouraged. Education could also include holistic education, spirituality, yogic philosophy, gardening and fruit picking as way of interacting with nature and understanding big concepts such as our purpose in life and the existence of a God. Further, mathematics can be taught in education through playing games and kids building their own tennis calculator in an Excel spreadsheet is an excellent way for creative flair in artwork (which utilizes electronic art or multimedia) which Indigenous Australians could potentially be quite good at.

Spiritual Counselling Through Social Media

Counselling psychology is a psychological specialty that encompasses research and applied work in several broad domains: counselling process and outcome; supervision and training; career development and counselling; and prevention and health. Some unifying themes among counselling psychologists include a focus on assets and strengths, person–environment interactions, educational and career development, brief interactions, and a focus on intact personalities.

A spiritual counsellor typically aims to help guide and advise individuals on all types of matters, whether they are spiritual in nature or not. Most spiritual counsellors will counsel individuals regarding traditional mental disorders, for instance, such as depression and anxiety, as well as more spiritually based problems. Of course, the type of work a spiritual counsellor performs will typically be determined by each individual client.

Counselling on a material level could be quite effective and given the author has previous known Dr Filia Papadimitriou (neighbours in 11 Findon St, Hawthorn, Melbourne) would recommend her practice. However, anything on a spiritual level will be more effective than anything on a material level (given that spiritual knowledge is a higher source of knowledge than material knowledge). Spiritual counselling from Hare Krishna Temples (in particular bona fide spiritual masters who are in disciplic succession from Lord Krishna – the Supreme Personality of Godhead), would be the most effective form of counselling. Also, Bhakti Yoga monks who live at Hare Krishna Temples would also be effective in terms of spiritual counselling as they regularly read Krishna consciousness books and interact with bona fide spiritual masters. Based on the author’s spiritual advancement from reading and understanding the Bhagavad Gita As It Is (after 3 times), would also be effective in spiritual counselling and therefore the information being distributed through social media (such as facebook) suggests that one’s health would improve. Note also that spiritual counselling through Hare Krishna temples and the author is a completely free service, whereas Dr Filia Papadimitriou charges for a 55-minute individual session \$220 and a couple’s session \$250.
